Re: TEA Class Size Waiver

As required by the Texas Education Code §25.112, we are required to submit a class size waiver request to the Texas Education Agency for any class sections in grades K-4 that exceed the state allowable class size limit of 22:1. Additionally, we are required to submit a compliant plan as to the action(s) that will be taken to bring the district back into compliance with the class size limitation.

Due to unanticipated student growth, and too few 3rd grade teachers to accommodate the growth, two sections in Grade 3 at Wilson Elementary exceeded the 22:1 ratio by one student in each of two sections in January, 2011. This waiver was approved by the Board at the January regular Board meeting and submitted to TEA.

Subsequently, in early February, 2011, an additional student was moved from a special program at Wilson into the 3rd grade regular classroom environment, thereby causing an additional 3rd grade class to increase to a 23:1 ratio. That is, three sections will now have a 23:1 ratio instead of the state mandated maximum of 22:1. In order to send this additional student from Wilson to another campus would not only require a new and separate bus route to transport the student, but would also be unnecessarily disruptive to the student this near the end of the school year. The principal of Wilson Elementary, Katy Cooper, requested this waiver in the educational best interest of this additional student.

After the waiver request is approved by TEA, TEC §25.113 requires that we provide written notice of the granted exception to the parent of each student affected by the exception. This would only include and relate to the 23 students in this additional 3rd grade section affected at Wilson Elementary.

Attached to this memo are the required waiver request and the compliance plan. Both documents require Board of Trustee approval, as well as Superintendent and Board President signatures.

Recommendation:

That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approve the Texas Education Agency Request for Maximum Class Size Waiver Exception form and the Compliance Plan as required by the Texas Education Code §25.112.
