Lunch in the Park numbers for the month of June are up by 284 over last year. We can contribute most of this increase because of the Boys and Girls Club of Rupert. With their summer activities they bring over their kids to Neptune Park for lunch. We have seen a small increase at Heyburn also. We see families at Heyburn that are coming over from Burley to eat with us. We have also seen an increase of 90 kids at Migrant School. You can see all the numbers on the charts that will be part of this report.

Our reimbursement for the month of June 2019 is \$62,256.19 compared to \$60, 323.91 for June of 2018.

We have received notification about the Fruit and Vegetable Grant for next year. We had five schools apply for the grant and all 5 schools received the grant. We were awarded a total of \$114,642.42 for the five schools. I will also attach a copy of the FFVP letter that we received from the state about this program. This letter will also break down the amount of money per school.

We have all of our food bids back and are in the process of awarding them. We had four companies bid on food this year and some of the same companies bid on paper and chemical products. We also had one company that just bid on paper and chemicals.

We will enter all the bids into the computer program and then the program will rate the bids from lowest to highest bid. We will then look over and make sure that the lowest bidders have met all the spec requirements before we award the bid to them.
