Introduction

Meridian 223 students participate in the Leader in Me program, based on *The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People*, at HE, MC, and MJHS.

Background

The Leader in Me (LiM) program is described as an evidence-based model for grades PK-12 that aims to:

- Build resilience and leadership in students
- Create a high-trust culture
- Improve academic achievement

The program equips students, educators, and families with leadership and life skills.

Currently, each school has its own subscription. By switching to a district subscription, we'll save about \$5,000 and receive an additional professional development day. Additionally, we'll also save 5% by signing a multi-year agreement.
