Winter Sports Update

As winter sports wrap up over the next several weeks, there were several notable achievements for our Chelsea Bulldogs:

- Senior Hunter Burk placed 7th at the MHSAA Division 2 Individual Wrestling Championships in the 126-pound weight class and earned All-State accolades.
- Competitive Cheer won their second consecutive SEC White Championship.
- Boys Swim and Dive broke a three-way tie atop the SEC White by winning the SEC White Invitational to claim their first SEC White title since 2015. Several qualifiers will compete in the MHSAA Division 3 Championships on March 14-15 at Eastern Michigan University. Andrew Thomson was named SEC White Coach of the Year.
- Boys bowling Camren Watson (7th) and girls bowling Jenna Velky (6th) advanced from regionals to qualify for the MHSAA Division 2 individual championships.
- Boys basketball won their third consecutive district championship on a last-second tip-in by junior Wyatt Matusik to defeat Parma Western. After defeating Goodrich in the regional semifinals, the boys will look for their third consecutive regional title against Lansing Sexton on Thursday, March 7.
- Girls basketball advanced to the district final on Friday, March 7 against Parma Western at Chelsea High School at 7:00 pm.
- While not a winter sport, the Michigan Interscholastic Track Coaches Association (MITCA) named boys track and field coach David Slusser and girls track and field coach Loren Thorburn 2024 D2 Region 16 coaches of the year.
