Cohorts/Teacher Prep

There will be four cohorts located at different buildings in the district.

K-2 Cohort will be at Bullshoe Elem. (Vina)

3-5 Cohort will be at BMS (depending upon registration numbers may have to be located at Bullshoe Elem.)

6-8 Cohort will be at BMS

9-12 Cohort will be at BHS

Teachers will need up to 8 hours of prep both individually and as a team prior to June 10th.

Project Based Learning

Each cohort will plan and implement Project Based Learning based upon the themes chosen by the teachers. The students will then choose specific topics from these themes to complete their PBL expectations.

The 9-12 cohort will also have Credit Recovery using the Edgenuity Online Learning Platform. Depending upon funding, field trips will be planned at a later date.

Eekahkimaht

Summer school will work in conjunction with Eekahkimaht to provide activities and supervision throughout the summer school day. The level of support provided by Eekahkimaht will be based upon the number of students and the support needed by the summer school staff. Eekahkimaht supervisor will make the final decisions on the level of support available.

Buses and Meals

Bus Pick Up/Drop Off

Bus pick up/drop off will begin daily at 8am. Students will complete bus requests when completing registration for summer school to identify route pick up/drop off. Student drop off after school will begin at 2pm after the completion of the daily instructional schedule.

Meals

Breakfast and lunch will be provided daily at each school. Breakfast will begin at 8am until 9:30am. Lunch will be 11:30am-12pm.

Summer School staff will be available from 8am-3pm daily. The daily staff schedule of each cohort will be developed based upon the amount of staffing and supervision support available. Breakfast and Lunch duty will be needed daily to supervise students during these times.

COHORT INFORMATION

This year there are two teachers for K-2 with 1 TA Two Teachers for 3-5 with 1 TA Two teachers for 6-8 Four teachers for 9-12 with 1 TA



Cohort K-2

There will be two teachers and 1 TA for this cohort. Up to 50 student spots available.

Cohort 3-5

There will be two teachers and 1 TA for this cohort. Up to 50 student spots available.

Cohort 6-8

There will be two teachers available for this cohort. Up to 50 student spots available. If there is a shortage of students one teacher will be reassigned.

Cohort 9-12

There will be 4 teachers and 1 TA available for this cohort. Up to 100 student spots available for PBL & Credit Recovery combined.



SpEd, Nurse, Counselor

There will be 1 SpEd teacher and 1 SpEd TA available for SpEd students who want to attend summer school. The location of this classroom is TBD. This class will be K-12 as assigned.

There will also be one Nurse available for all cohorts combined.

There is also one counselor available for all students K-12 to help with counseling, SEL support, and transcript review.



Student Registration

Student registration will begin on May 27, 2024 until June 7, 2024. Registration will be at the front office of school building. Registration will continue on June 10. A district wide spreadsheet will be created and students will be added to the proper cohort as they register. Each cohort will need to remain within the student-teacher ratio so once that number is determined the number of slots available will be set. Registration will be on a first come first serve basis. Once the ratio is filled there will be no students allowed to join.
