May 2025 Transportation Report

- 1. This Summer will be transporting two out of district students to extended school year services. One student to Schramm and one to High Roads for their extended school year needs provided through their IEP.
- 2. This summer all the drivers will need to take their yearly refresher course to maintain their license. This Summer I have 1 person who has reached out to work on getting their licenses this summer.
- 3. As of today our 2 new buses still have not been delivered. It looks as though they should be here soon. This summer, we will also be getting 2 more at the start of the next fiscal year. We are needing to replace one of our 7 passenger vans this summer as well. I will start looking for options to replace that.
- 4. We were able to facilitate 39 field trips this school year. We were able to facilitate all of these. We are now up to full staff.
- 5. This school year, to date, we have utilized 10 buses and 2 vans to drive a total of 179,501 miles. These miles are for transporting students to and from Illini Central, Schramm School in Pekin (1), Kiefer in Peoria(1), 2 Elementary Schools in Lincoln (1 to Central and 1 to Northwest), Lincoln High School for LTEC (16), High Roads in Bloomington (2), and Hammitt in Bloomington (1). The average number of students transported per day is 249 (excluding LTEC and after school shuttle).
- 6. We have switched completely to using our electronic forms. Every driver has an lpad to submit timesheets, track mileage, bus rider attendance and we implemented an electronic conduct report to handle discipline quicker. This has made our tracking systems more efficient and up to date in real time. We did away with the onboard internet on the buses. We upgraded the internet at the bus garage and the parking lot to update the drivers ipads.
- 7. All the buses are current on their state inspections and maintenance.
