

POLICY REVISIONS

A major function of the School Board is reviewing, revising, and adopting District #622 policies. Three policies have been proposed for revision to incorporate MSBA recommended changes which reflect statutory requirements that the Minnesota legislature enacted through the legislative session and other federal and state requirements. These updates quote directly from new Minnesota laws and other legal sources or are clerical updates that do not affect the substance of a policy.

The wide range of new Minnesota laws and the ongoing clarifications that state agencies, including the Minnesota Department of Education, continue to provide, MSBA is committed to providing ongoing updates to model policies.

Therefore, the Superintendent of Schools recommends the following resolution:
