School Culture	<p>Mental Health First Aid:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Gary Wade is incorporating this training into his Decisions class. This is a sophomore level class that all our students take. This will be the 2nd year of this training for our students. Research has shown that half of all mental illnesses begin by age 14 and 75% by the mid-20s. Teens sometimes go to adults, but the majority go to friends seeking help/advice. This curriculum helps teens identify, understand and respond to signs of mental health and substance use challenges among their friends. The training gives teens the skills to have supportive conversations with friends and get a responsible and trusted adult to take over as necessary. <p>Senior Class Trip Update:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Seniors will be going to Galveston, Texas again this year for the Senior Class Trip.
