REPORTING STUDENT PROGRESS 7

8 On-going evaluation of student progress is essential both for the academic development of student and for the information of students and parents. All students should be evaluated regularly by 9 teachers in a professional manner consistent with the needs and ability of each student. Student's 10 progress will be reported reflecting the child's skills and development in comparison with same age 11 peers, the District curriculum objectives, and individual student growth. 12

14 **TEACHER EVALUATION OF STUDENT PROGRESS**

All teachers are responsible for the on-going professional evaluation of students *in* their charge for 15 the day or any portion of the day. Evaluation will be based on multiple measures, which may 16 include paper pencil tasks, student performance, and/or demonstration of content mastery relative to 17 stated curriculum or individual goals. 18

REPORTS OF STUDENT PROGRESS 20

21 Parent Reports

22 Provide parents/families with information on their student's progress at least twice monthly 23 quarterly and as requisted. This report may include noted strengths of the student, concerns, general information about curriculum or extra curricular eligibility status when applicable. 24 However, formal written summaries of student progress shall be made at a minimum of nine (9) 25 week intervals. District approved forms shall be utilized for this purpose. Parent/teacher conferences 26 27 will be scheduled a minimum of two times per year.

- 29 Superintendent Report of Student Progress

The Superintendent shall periodically present to the Board a summary of student progress. The report 30 shall contain both quantitative and qualitative data. Each semester, a summary of all students' 31 32 academic progress, average grades, attendance, etc. shall be presented to the Board of Trustees. All 33 school-based K-12 testing (SBAC, ACT, SAT, ASVAB, etc.) will be summarized and submitted to 34 the Board of Trustees as results are finalized by test administrators.
