Kindergarten

Started the month continuing to learn about informational texts and informative writing but will then move into research. We will also review story elements with some great Thanksgiving themed books. We will also be working on numbers 11-15 and adding and subtracting up to 10. In social studies we will begin our geography unit which means we will learn about landforms, bodies of water, maps and directionality. To end our month, we will have a Thanksgiving feast.

First Grade
