Re: Board Report

College Application Week: All of our Homedale High School seniors participated in the College Application Week. It is a nationwide program to help every high school student apply for a post-secondary degree. This year, during the week of November 10-14, all Idaho high school seniors were encouraged to apply to as many post-secondary institutions as possible. All application fees were waved during college application week. The stats below show how many of our Homedale High School seniors participated.

College Application Week Stats:

- Military 4/90=4%
- One or more college applications: 82/90 =91%
- Undecided or working 5/90 = 5%

Veteran's Day Assembly: November 11th Homedale High School had a very successful Veteran's Day Assembly. Bailey Adams organized the Veteran's Day assembly as her senior project. Many veterans and parents attended the assembly along with the Homedale High School student body.

COSSA Teen Risk Workshop: About 20 Homedale High School students who are currently enrolled in classes at COSSA, plus about 24 students who are taking part in the sources of strength program attended COSSA's Teen Risk Workshop of November 13th. This all day event was attended by students from all five consortium high schools. Students were able to attend workshops on drugs, alcohol, meth, and college reps were also available to talk to students and provide them with post- secondary information.

Parent Teacher Conferences: Parent Teacher Conferences was attended by approximately 65 parents on Monday night November 17th. Attendance was down, but I believe it was due to bad weather.

College Visitation: December 4th The Go On and Gear up grants are paying for all of our 10th grade students to tour CWI and BSU. The students will also visit the Ann Frank Memorial on this trip.

Span Idaho: Span Idaho came to Homedale High School Friday December 5th and provided a free community training.

The training covered:

- how to recognize and respond to suicide warning signs in youth and adults
- how to talk to those in crisis and refer them to help
- why people die by suicide
- what suicide looks like in Idaho
- what is true and false about suicide
- what to tell youth about suicide
- what resources are available to assist those who need help
- about a youth wellness program that is coming to your community

Strive for College: Homedale High School Seniors have been coming at 6:50 a.m. every Thursday since October 16th to meet with their college mentor online to discuss all of the challenges that the HS seniors will face while preparing for their post-secondary education. The seniors' final meeting with their mentors will happen face to face on Saturday December 6th The Strive program has been very successful here at Homedale High School and has provided many of our juniors and seniors the support they needed to prepare them for their post-secondary education.
