Purpose:

Federal law requires that districts receiving federal funds hold a public hearing to allow for public input related to proposed expenditures of all federal grants prior to submitting the applications.

Summary:

If a district receives more than \$5,000 in block grant funds to be used as the district determines is appropriate, it shall provide evidence to TEA that a public meeting or hearing was held in a timely manner solely to seek public comment on the needs or uses of block grant funds received by the district. The board may hold this meeting or hearing in conjunction with another board meeting or hearing if the meeting or hearing to consider block grant funds is clearly noted in an announcement of the other meeting or hearing.
