BE IT RESOLVED, by the School Board of Independent School District No. 832, that, pursuant to Minnesota Statute 122A.40, Subdivision 5, the teaching contract of Michael Hagen, a probationary teacher in Independent School District No. 832, is hereby terminated at the close of the current 2016-2017 school year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that written notice be sent to said teacher regarding termination and non-renewal of his/her contract as provided by law, and that said notice shall be in substantially the following form:

You are hereby notified that, at a regular meeting of the School Board of Independent School District No. 832, held on April 13, 2017, a resolution was adopted by a majority roll call vote to terminate your contract effective at the end of the current school year and not to renew your contract for the 2017-18 school year. Said action of the Board is taken pursuant to M.S. 122A.40, Subdivision 5.

You may officially request that the School Board give its reasons for non-renewal of the teaching contract. However, such request should be received within ten (10) days after the receipt of this notice.
