




- What could we do to improve safety measures in our schools? ((comments))
 - Continue to be vigilant and work on the bullying issues
 - Leave SRO in place and work on-line (cheaper than books or metal detectors)
 - Firearms training
 - Cameras with constant viewing @ entryways
 - Locked Buzz-in doors
 - Staff training on specific protocol
 - Enforce the safety measures and rules you have in place-do drills to practice what to do- do not ignore bulling
 - Keep SRO position and add more surveillance cameras, lock front doors and classrooms and add fencing
 - Who is responsible for who comes in and what are the criteria for allowing or denying admittance
