Re: Acuity Scores

Attached are summary reports that show student performance trends from a district-wide perspective for each Acuity test administered this school year.

Results from the reading / language arts assessment indicate that:

- Approximately 70% of students are projected to meet or exceed standards on the Illinois Standards Achievement Test.
- The majority of grade levels showed an increase in the number of students projected to meet or exceed standards on the Illinois Standards Achievement Test from Acuity A to C.
 - Fourth, sixth and eighth grades showed significant (more than three percentage points) increases in the number of students projected to meet or exceed standards on the Illinois Standards Achievement Test.

Results from the mathematics assessment indicate that:

- Approximately 70% of students are projected to meet or exceed standards in Mathematics on the Illinois Standards Achievement Test.
- Overall, student performance profiles remained stable (less than three percentage point increase/decrease) from Acuity A to Acuity C.
 - Third grade students showed a significant decline (more than three percentage points) in the number of students projected to meet or exceed standards on the Illinois Standards Achievement Test.
 - Eighth grade students showed a significant increase (more than three percentage points) in the number of students projected to meet or exceed standards on the Illinois Standards Achievement Test.

Percentage of Students Predicted to "Meet or Exceed" ISAT Standards






