#### **Project Description:**


Regional flood mitigation project with nearly 100 ac-ft of detention volume

#### Purpose:

Reduce the loss of life and property due to flooding in the Memorial City Area.

#### Need:

Reduce flooding and future flood losses in the area. Lower the water surface elevation during flood events in Ditches W151-00-00 and W153-00-00 and reduce street and structural flooding in the community south of the Memorial City Area.










#### **PROPOSED STORM SEWER SYSTEM**





- 2015 Shifted to Current Project with Detention Under MMS
  - Extensive Search for Other Detention Options
  - Initiated Discussions with SBISD




#### Flood Reduction:

- Structures Removed from Flooding (100-yr): 111

- Inundation Area Reduction (Acres): 37 (100-yr)






- Short Term Financial Impact Compensation for Drainage Easement
- Long Term Financial Impact Working Closely with SBISD Team to Ensure Future School Constructability






- How Does this Potentially Impact the Future Reconstruction of Memorial Middle School?
  - Structure concerns with 3-story school on vault?
  - Will this increase our risk of flooding due to detention vault under the northern half of the future school?
  - Ongoing coordination effort with SBISD team.
    - School Utilities: Sanitary Sewer, Water
    - School Campus Stormwater Runoff
    - Foundation Design
  - Draft interlocal agreement with terms between the City and SBISD intended to facilitate the future school construction.








