Staff will be offering tutoring services (all subjects), STEM, STREAM Experiments/Activities (Science, Technology, Reading, Arts & Math) Family engagement activities, College Career opportunities will be offered weekly. Time and days vary at each center.

Ee-Kah-Ki-Maht open gym is held at BES due to multiple spring sports practices we are down to one gym Browning Elementary Gym. Open Gym is offered Monday – Thursdays 7:00pm-10:00pm and we have been averaging around 60-100 students throughout the week. Middle School and High School have been showing up nightly.
