2025-2026 Meal Prices

Background Information

The Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010 – Section 205, requires schools to raise school meal prices to be more in line with the Federal reimbursement rates. Effective July 1, 2011, schools are required to increase the price of paid meals if the price charged is less than the difference between the Federal reimbursement rate for free meals and paid meals. The USDA provides a Paid Lunch Equity (PLE) tool to determine the “weighted average paid lunch price” each year to determine the new paid lunch price or the amount of non-federal funds that must be contributed to the child nutrition fund.

This requirement is not applicable to breakfast, staff, or adult meals. The District reviews meal prices for breakfast and lunch for students, staff, and adult meals on an annual basis and adjusts prices as necessary to cover food and labor costs to produce meals.

Administration recommends an increase in meal prices as presented in the attached document. The requested increases ensure the District is compliant with the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010, as well as covers the increasing cost of components necessary to meet meal pattern requirements.
