TITLE: Approval of Fee for Canyon Del Oro High School Summer Bridge Program for Incoming Freshman

BACKGROUND:

The past several years, Canyon Del Oro High School has offered incoming Freshman the opportunity to attend the Bridge Program. The program provides students with a week-long experience that supports students' promotion to high school.

Throughout the experience, students interact with teachers, administrators, and students involved in CDO's Link Crew, to promote a successful transition to high school. Incoming students are able to develop positive relationships with students mentors, learn to navigate the school campus, hone organizational strategies that support positive academic performance, and forge new friendships with other incoming freshman.

Previously, the Bridge Program was funded using ESSER monies; however, with the elimination of these funds, Canyon Del Oro High School would need to assess a nominal fee to continue the program that supports students' transition to high school.

Based on the last several years' enrollment in the Bridge program, a \$55.00 fee would cover the cost of staff who facilitate the program and related supplies students use during their experience.
