BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This request is pursuant to Section 26.08, Property Tax Code.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

Per Section 26.08 (a) of the Property Tax Code, if the governing body of a school district adopts a tax rate that exceeds the district's rollback tax rate, the registered voters of the district at an election held for that purpose must determine whether to approve the adopted tax rate and (b) the governing body shall order that the election be held in the school district on a date not less than 30 or more than 90 days after the day on which it adopts the tax rate.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Costs associated with conducting this election have been included in the 2017-2018 fiscal year budget. Costs will be paid from the General Fund.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

Compliance with Section 26.08 of the Property Tax Code.
