SELECTION TIMELINE



August 2013	IMA Committee 2013-2015 Budget Analysis including Proclamation 2014 Allocation Projections
September 2013	Sample materials requested from publishers by Instructional Materials Coordinator
November 2013	Instructional Officer Orientation Meeting with agenda addressing selection procedures, sample materials, and board policy prohibitions.
November 2013	Began receiving printed sample materials at Textbook Warehouse for distribution to campuses. Online digital samples available from each publisher.
December 2013	IMA Committee Meeting to review district instructional materials selection criteria, SBOE Adopted Instructional Materials and EPISD eligible publisher list.
November 2013 to February 2014	Campus Instructional Officers distribute sample materials to all teachers and create textbook advisory committees. Advisory committee members review sample materials and conduct an analysis of curriculum TEKS objectives and activities for each textbook option. Recommendations are made to the IMA Committee.
February 7, 2014	Campus teachers vote for top three publisher systems. Top three publishers are invited to present system at Preview event.
February 2014	Top Three Publisher Preview Sessions February 26, 2014 – K-5, 6-8 Math Publisher Presentations, 5:00-8:00pm @ EPJH February 27, 2014 – K-5, 6-8, 9-12 Science Pub. Presentations, 5:00-8:00pm @ EPJH
March 21, 2014	Final campus vote and tally of Instructional Materials recommendations to IMA Committee. Campus representatives allowed the opportunity to submit rationale for Instructional Materials selections including print or online options.
April 2014	IMA Committee evaluates and analyzes campus recommendations in regard to available funding and future goals.
May 2014	Submission of IMA Committee recommendations for Board review and ratification.
