BACKGROUND:

Each year the Southern Arizona Research, Science and Engineering Foundation (SARSEF) celebrates young researchers and scientists from grades K-12 at a science fair competition. Winning science fair projects at the school level are selected to compete at the Southern Arizona Research, Science and Engineering Fair (SARSEF). This year, the competitions were held virtually, and more than 2,700 projects from 139 schools were submitted throughout the contest process.

Amphitheater Public Schools had 90 projects from 10 schools across the district advance to the SARSEF competition. A total of 65 projects received special awards or 1st or 2nd place honors. A full list of winners is enclosed.
