Student Products and Performances

 The United ISD Gifted & Talented (GT) Student Showcases provide an opportunity for students to showcase products and performances to the public at the district level.

• Student representatives from each elementary campus participate in the GT showcases.

2nd Grade Student Project



The student researched the life of Frida Kahlo and noted changes over time, patterns, ethics, and unanswered questions. She emulated Kahlo's style in her original art work.

5th Grade Student Project



The student expressed a generalization based on the grade level theme, systems, and noted patterns, multiple perspectives, changes over time, big ideas, and ethics involved in volunteer work at the local animal shelter. She created a brochure with information on volunteering to raise awareness of need in our community. She displayed her letter to the editor requesting help for the local animal shelter along with an album of pictures of her own volunteer work at the shelter.
