**Background Information:**

- Texas Primary Reading Inventory (TPRI)/ Tejas Lee (Spanish)- state required reading inventory for students in grades K-2
- Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System (TELPAS) for English language learners in grades 2-12
- ACT – National college admission examination including English, Math, Reading, Science, and Writing
- SAT- National college admission examination measuring critical thinking skills needed for academic success in college
- Advanced Placement (AP) Exams measuring performance in various high school courses including core content, fine arts, foreign language, and computer science
- Performance-Based Monitoring Analysis System (PBMS) includes data from Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS), dropouts, graduation data, Academic Excellence Indicator System (AEIS), Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) and PEIMS

**Administrative Considerations:**

- The report for assessment and performance data will include three year trend data, areas of strength and opportunities for improvement.
