Our varsity boys' soccer team had another successful season. After finishing as the district runner-up, we defeated Jasper in the 1st round before losing to a very good Royal team in the 2nd round of the playoffs to end our season. Our season record was 13-7-1 overall and our district record was 6-1-1. Our JV boys had an overall record of 11-5-1 and a district record of 7-0-1. Our varsity girls' soccer team finished the season with an 2-14-1 overall record and had a district record of 0-8. Our JV girls finished with an overall record of 1-7-3 and an 0-8 district record.
