HOPE, ENGAGEMENT, AND WELL-BEING STUDENT POLL RESULTS

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FALL 2012 U.S. GALLUP STUDENT POLL PARTICIPATION

- The Gallup Student Poll was live from Tuesday, October 2 through Friday, November 2, 2012.
- In 2012, a total of **479,439** public school students participated in the U.S.
 - Fall 2011: 326,426
 - Fall 2010: 266,971
 - Fall 2009: 246,682
- 1,751 schools, representing 195 school districts.
 - 1,300 elementary schools (n=79,769)
 - 292 middle schools (n=206,410)
 - 171 high schools (n=193,260)
 - 37 states
- 47% year to year increase in participation from 2011 to 2012.
- **1,519,096** total U.S. completes to date*
- Two districts in Canada and a couple schools in Australia also participated.
