**DESCRIPTION:**

Community Education (CE) will continue to offer referral-only remedial reading and math classes using Targeted Services funding. These classes are mostly taught by BHM teachers and are free of charge to in-district children. This year, 519 students were referred for reading and/or math. Students who are referred for Targeted Services may also choose enrichment classes in the Sun Block program and use our centralized transportation from each of the District elementary schools.

KidKare students will also participate in the Sun Block program as part of their day and will choose from a wide variety of enrichment classes offered. The Targeted Services and Sun Block program will be located at Tatanka Elementary STEM School and Phoenix Learning Center this year. It will be offered Monday-Thursday, 8:30-11:30 from June 18 through August 2. This will be an additional 12 hours of service to students from what we offered last year.

Students attending CE summer programs will again have breakfast and lunch at no cost by taking advantage of the USDA Summer Food Program.

In addition to the Sun Block program, CE continues to offer a wide variety of activities and events for children and adults in the BHM communities. Below is a list of examples of the opportunities CE will provide this the summer:

- ECFE Concerts in the Park
- School Readiness classes 2 days a week in Buffalo and Montrose
- ECFE mixed age classes
- Early Childhood Screening
- Family Literacy/GED classes
- KidKare
- Youth Recreation Camps - tennis, football, basketball, volleyball, gymnastics
- Youth Enrichment afternoon classes - STEM, robotics, coding, theater, music, arts
- SPARK in Montrose
- Swimming lessons- Country Inn pool and Pulaski Beach
- Robotics Camps - Elementary/Middle School

- Mock Trial
- High School Driver Education - locations at HES, MES and BHS
- Adult Enrichment – Old Log Theater, State Fair, ballroom dancing, art
- Adults with Disabilities – MN Twins game, prom night, picnics, fishing
