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## Obligations of the Parties/Early Literacy:

#### **School District shall:**

- 1. Hire classified personnel to provide extend summer library hours at summer feeding sites for a total of 6 weeks, 3 times per week, 4 hours per day with scheduled story times and developmentally and culturally competent read-aloud books for school age children.
- 2. Appoint a project lead to coordinate/ report on all aspects of the project, including reports on participation and qualitative feedback from parents.
- 3. Deliver a final written report by September 15, 2014 including:
  - participation numbers,
  - qualitative feedback from parents, and
  - detailed project expenditures.
- 4. Promote open library times to encourage use by children and families, whenever possible in conjunction with local public libraries.
- 5. School District shall comply with any applicable requirements under the CCO Contract for Early Literacy, between Yamhill CCO and The Oregon Department of Education.

### **Agreement Details:**

- 1. Yamhill CCO agrees to pay \$1,870 for open summary libraries;
- 2. Salaries and benefits in this agreement are for classified personnel hired to maintain open library times; total of 6 weeks, 3 times per week, 4 hours per day.

## Yamhill CCO Early Learning Hub shall:

- 1. Make one payment summer of 2014 to cover salary and benefits for classified personnel hired to maintain open library times.
- 2. Purchase 100 developmentally and culturally appropriate books for children ages 0-4 to be made available for in library read aloud times.
- 3. Provide gently used books to be given to children grades K-3<sup>rd</sup> grade.
- 4. Provide templates for reporting.
