## 11.13 <u>AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE TAKE-HOME BOOKS AND BAGS FOR</u> GRADES K-2 AT BROWNELL STEM ACADEMY FROM HEINEMANN

The Office of State, Federal and Local Programs is seeking authorization to purchase 36 sets of Kindergarten take-home books for \$11,340, 34 sets of 1<sup>st</sup> grade take-home books for \$16,830, 34 sets of 2<sup>nd</sup> grade take-home books for \$18,360, 40 sets of My Writing Book for \$960 and 50 sets of take-home bags for \$950 from Heinemann for Brownell Stem Academy.

Brownell K-2 STEM Academy received Title I funding from the Michigan Department of Education to support student learning and intervention services. As part of the school's efforts to address the academic needs and provide more opportunities for at-risk students to learn, we are using the Leveled Literacy Intervention Program to improve reading and writing proficiency.

Funding is available for the purchase of take-home books, My Writing Books and take-home bags from Heinemann from Brownell Stem Academy's Title I funds.

On the basis of the preceding information, the following resolution is proposed.

Be it Resolved, That

The Flint Board of Education

Authorizes the purchase of 104 sets of take-home books for grades K-2, 40 sets of My Writing Book and 50 sets of take-home bags from Heinemann for the total quoted price not to exceed Forty Eighty Thousand, Four Hundred and Forty Dollars (\$48,440) for Brownell Stem Academy.
