AGENDA ITEM: Consider Approval of IXL Learning Math & Real-Time Diagnostic Assessment

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Per Board Policy CH (Legal/Local), purchase of goods or services valued at \$50,000, or more, shall require Board approval before a transaction may take place.
- IXL Real-Time Diagnostic is a research-based, computer-adaptive math assessment that allows educators to gather progress and grade-level equivalency data around six math strands: Numbers and Operations, Algebra & Algebraic Thinking, Fractions, Geometry, Measurement, Statistics & Probability.
- If approved, this assessment will be given three times a year as a math screener and progress monitoring tool in grades 3-8 and for students in Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II. The data from the Real-Time Diagnostic assessment will drive instruction by targeting specific skills that require additional time for mastery.
- The IXL Learning math program gives teachers access to the entire online K-12 curriculum which will equip teachers with additional math materials for differentiated instruction either in the classroom or through online skill practice.
- The cost associated with purchasing IXL Learning for the 2020-2021 school year is as follows:
 - IXL Math District Site License (Grades K-8 and high school courses including Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II) = \$54,900
 - IXL Professional Development Package = \$4,125
 - Existing Subscription Credit = (\$831)
 - Total Purchase Price = \$58,194

FISCAL INFORMATION:

- Purchase cost of \$58,194 will be paid from Instructional Materials Allotment, Fund 410.
