



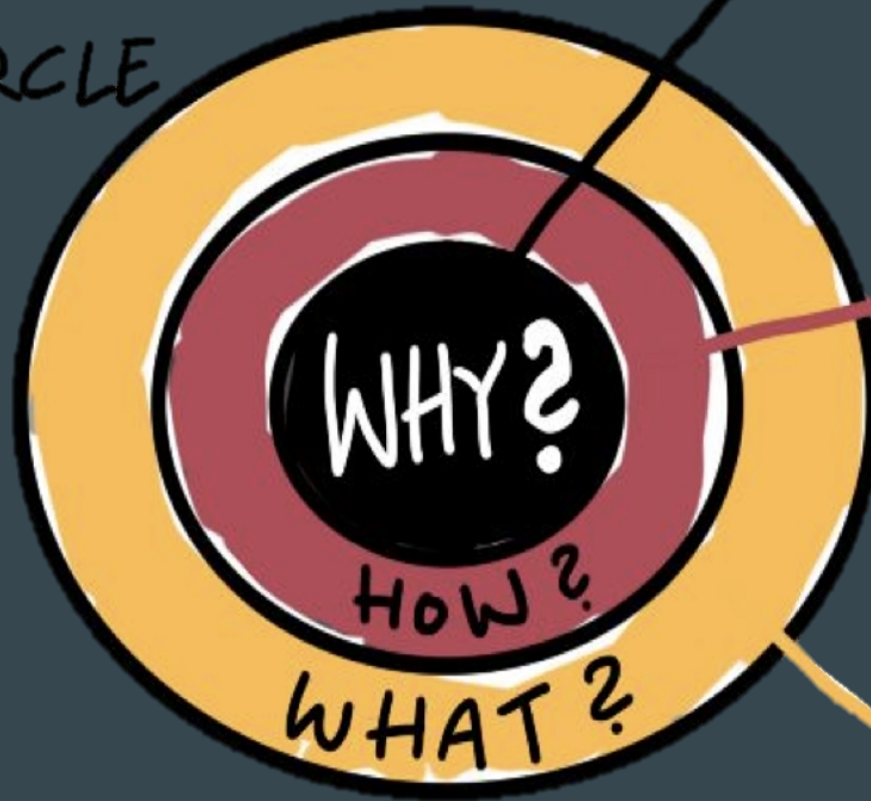

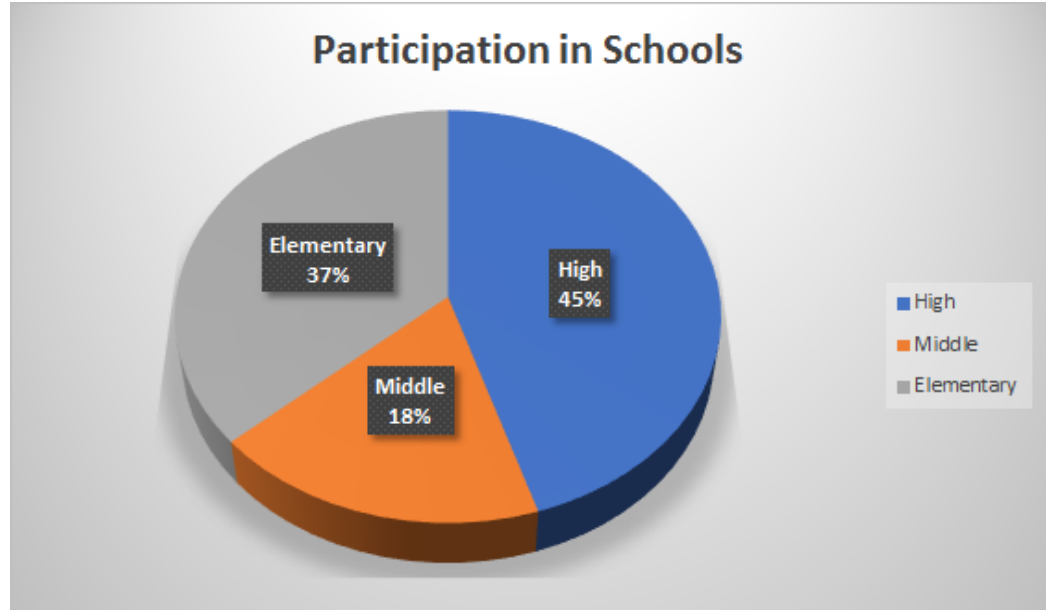

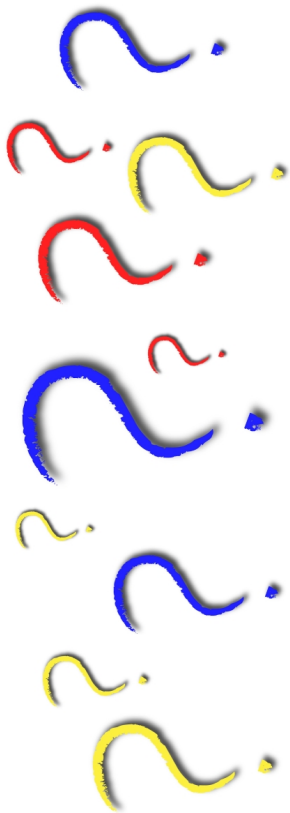
How do you use your computer during the day? Please include instructional and daily tasks.

Able to attach almost all peripherals	Keeps teachers tied to one place in the room
Printing	Cannot take home
Presentation station with projector	
Not dependent on wifi	

Chromebook

Pros & Cons

Pros	Cons
Small mobile form factor	No “downloadable” software
Energy efficient	Cannot print
Ability to take home or to Professional Development	
Allows for mobility around the classroom	
Touchscreen	
Flips 360 degrees for ease of use and carry
