2. Communications Update

3. Class Offerings  
Class offerings in the high school change based on staffing as well as the number of students who sign up for classes.
4. Transportation  
I have a recommendation to move forward with MTN as our transportation provider for next year and beyond. This item will provide an update on how we arrived at this conclusion as well as what the transition timeline will look like once the board makes a decision at the regular board meeting on the 24th.
5. Legislative Update  
Terese and I will be attending the MSBA Day at the Capitol on Monday and we should be able to share what we learned.
6. Fund Balance Policy  
There are a number of different approaches to a fund balance policy. Chris and I will be recommending increasing the threshold from 5% to 12%.
7. Survey Results  
The folks from SiteLogiq will be on site to share the results of the survey regarding preschool. In my opinion, it verified what I thought we would see. It is interesting, and I believe this will provide a springboard on how to proceed.
8. 2026 Three Year Policy Reviews
