Should the Board reject a person nominated by the Superintendent, it shall be the Superintendent's duty to make another nomination.</p> <p>In determining the recommendation, the Superintendent may consider the advice of the building Principal and the Administrative Recommendation Committee. In determining the recommendation of an administrative position, the Superintendent may consider the advice of an Administrative Recommendation Committee appointed by the Board.
