The wiring rough in for the Fire Alarm Replacement in the Tech Center started on January 21st and was completed February 7th. The Electricians worked nights to minimize the disruption to the learning environment. The new alarms, lights and pull stations are scheduled for installation and testing over the coming weeks. We expect to have the project totally completed by Spring Break.
