## **Another Year Comes to a Close:**


It was a record setting year at Buffalo Hide Academy with 43 graduates. It is always a

#### Backcountry Art (Grades 9-12)

This two week course will take students on daily field trips to Glacier National Park and other areas. Activities such as hiking, swimming, trail running, and peak climbing will get our students to beautiful spots where they will use the inspiration of the landscape and physical activity to create art! 30 students max!

#### Elective credit will be available if needed for high school students

#### Lil' Scramblers (Grades 4-8)

This two week course will involve day trips to Glacier and other spots on the Blackfeet reservation. We'll be doing some hiking, swimming, and playing traditional games throughout these two weeks. We will be accepting up to 30 students a day!
