5. TRUTH IN TAXATION PRESENTATION, Gary Kawlewski

Information to be presented is the current year budget and actual revenue and expenses for the prior year. Tax levy is set in December for the calendar year. School budget is approved in June. Total revenue for 2012-13 budget is \$7.2 million compared to \$6.8 million in 2011-12. Expenditures for 2012-13 budget is \$6.9 million compared to \$6.6 million for 2011-12. Community Service fund includes opening of Little KidKare Center. Total staff FTE has remained around 600 for the last four years. School district levy has decreased by \$351,280 or 2.67%. Referendum revenue is decreasing due to decreasing property values and therefore, a greater portion being paid by state aid. Voter approved debt service which includes the refunding of the high school bonds will provide a savings of \$450,000 annually. Property taxes are decreasing due to decrease of Estimated Market Value and Taxable Market Value.

Public comment:

Allan Malerich – The state owes the districts money. Would receipt of this money affect the district levy? This would not affect the amount of the levy but would save the district money they pay out for short-term borrowing.
