- Eliminates need for good cause exemption, makes us compliant in HB 3

- LISD supplies one per year
- One 5.5 x 8.5 non-clear bag

Plan to have a clear backpack policy
K-12 and all athletic events in 2026-2027
school year!

2026-2027 K-12 Students

- Clear mesh or vinyl backpack
- One 5.5" x 8.5" non-clear bag
- Snyder ISD will furnish one per student

2026-2027 Athletic Events

- 12" x 12" x 6" clear plastic/vinyl or one gallon ziploc
- One 5.5" x 8.5" non-clear bag
- No backpacks

Bus Accidents Safety Response

Two recent incidents

- February 27, AM Bus 2
 - 20 Students with no injuries
 - 37th and Ave. A
 - Police, EMS, and Administrators
 - EMS triage at the scene, HS nurse also evaluated and contacted parents
 - All parents contacted personally
- March 2, AM Bus 4
 - 13 Students with no injuries
 - 37th and El Paso
 - DPS, Police and Administrators
 - Driver had rider map ready when officers arrived
 - Primary nurse evaluated
 - All parents contacted personally



Bus Accidents

**What we can
do better!**

Bus drivers now have current rider logs, accident log, accident rider map, and printed steps available in all buses in Red safety folder.

Moving forward, next year, after the implementation of the BusRight system

- Current bus rider log available
- Immediate access to contacts
- Immediate ability to reroute, combine routes, etc.



Next steps

- Work with the Snyder Police Department building a more streamlined SRO program
- Prepare for clear backpacks
- Complete visits with AI weapon detection being used in neighboring districts
