RECOMMENDATION:

The Board approval of a Delegate and Alternate for the 2026 (TASB) Delegate Assembly.

IMPACT/RATIONALE:

The Delegate Assembly gives the board the chance to participate in the democratic process that governs TASB. Delegates will elect TASB officers and directors, vote on TASB's Advocacy Agenda, have the opportunity to interact with other board members in our region, and earn continuing education training credit.

The 2026 Delegate Assembly will be held Friday, October 9, during txEDCON in Houston. Registration opens on July 21st.

This year's Assembly is going to be a little different. Here are the four key things to know:

The day and time are changing, but it is still be held during txEDCON. Delegate Assembly will be Friday, Oct. 9, with the caucus meetings at 10 a.m. and the Assembly (with complimentary lunch) at 11:30 a.m. Also, all events will be at the convention center.

Both Delegates and Alternates will be permitted on the Assembly floor. Each Active Member board present will continue to have only one vote, but the Delegate and Alternate can sit together.

CEC credit is back! The agenda has been reworked to ensure there is time for training. Attendees will learn about creating and elevating local legislative priorities. The session will be worth 45 minutes of CEC.

There will be a new agenda item focused on supporting members. Delegates will provide input on the Association's content and training priorities for the coming year.
