Call to Order The work session was called to order at 6:00 pm by Vice Chairman, Craig Miles; and a quorum was established. The purpose of the work session was to discuss: the Value Engineered Adjustment to the PTE Building at Irrigon; the Heppner-Lexington CEC; and Elementary PE and property acquisition by Windwave.	
Ned Luthey, from Sargeant Architects was present to explain the value engineered adjustment to the Irrigon PTE building. He noted that the original footprint has not been changed. Some things to help lower the cost of the building were: moving the building 27 feet to the east to be closer to the utilities; \$45,000 in landscape projects were removed; welding area was reduced. This building is comparable to what Hermiston and Pendleton currently have. Contracts will be signed on June 29 th and construction will begin immediately with a 180 day completion target. The value engineered adjustment to the PTE building came in at \$915,000.
