Dear Mr. Goss,

Frederick Construction greatly appreciates the partnership and opportunities we have with Vicksburg Community Schools to manage the bidding process, provide recommendations, as well as provide field and administrative construction management services to the district's proposed projects.

Frederick Construction was requested by Vicksburg Community Schools to create bid documents and manage the bid process for the Athletic Stadium Sound System Improvement project, part of the districts 2022 General Fund projects.

Vicksburg Community Schools received 3 proposals for 1 bid package that was solicited as Release 1-Athletic Stadium Sound System Improvements on March 31, 2022. One proposal provided by Acorn was not accepted due to failure to meet the Bid Requirements (*see attached Bid Tab*).

B.P. 27.1 – Audio Improvements

The Bid Package Work Scope consists of: Removal of existing audio gear in the press box and the existing outdoor audio speakers. New audio equipment and outdoor speakers will be installed and tested in replacement of the equipment being removed. An alternate to provide a temporary audio system for the May 2022 graduation commencement services was also requested with proposals, but at this time will not be included in our recommendation.

We are recommending that this bid package be awarded to SVT

Furthermore, Frederick Construction proposes that the district continues with construction management as advisor (CMA) services provided by Frederick Construction Inc. to manage contract creation, pre-construction submissions, periodic site supervision, and post construction trainings and record management. These costs are indicated below and are detailed in an attached Frederick Construction fee schedule.
