# What is one significant issue facing students in our district today, and how should the Board address it?

One significant issue facing our students in our district today is the growing mental health crisis. Students face heavy amounts of pressure, stress, anxiety, due to academic pressures, sports, and even social dynamics. This is something that can discourage students from participating and truly experiencing highschool. In fact, almost half of the children in the United States have experienced at least one adverse childhood experience. Adverse childhood experiences (ACE's) are potentially traumatic events that have lasting effects on health which could stem into chronic health conditions. It is important for students to know that mental health is something to be taken seriously and there are various ways this can be approached. The Board can address it by ensuring that students have access to crisis hotlines, create mental health surveys, and provide resources to those who need it. Previously, I have worked with a nonprofit called 16strong to learn and educate others about ACE's and mental health. If there was any possibility that the school district could work with community and local mental health organizations to spread more awareness and resources for support and/or even therapy that would be helpful to many. By taking steps as such, the Board can proactively address the growing mental health crisis that can challenge many students especially when they may be held to higher standards. Fostering a school environment where all students feel welcomed and supported is important and these steps help ensure students reach their full potential.
