

## Fourth Grade Classrooms



## Art Room Seating








Seats warping on many stools & have been repaired/soldered multiple times creating safety issues for students

Replace tables and chairs in Kindergarten and 4th Grade classrooms with flexible & updated options.



Update 6 shared hallway spaces, to offer collaborative seating, comfort and flexibility for small groups learning.



A new set of art stools will improve the overall safety, aesthetics and comfort of the shared art space.

Flexible back/stackable chairs, adjustable leg tables with casters for multiple configurations





## Main Hallway Collaboration








Tables with flip/lock option & nesting stools
