TEA: Operation Connectivity

Board Goal:

In pursuit of excellence, the district will:

- Incorporate best practices into teaching, learning, technology and leadership
- Foster and support an advanced digital learning environment

Purpose of Report

The purpose of this report is to provide the trustees with information about the Texas Education Agency technology funding opportunity called "Operation Connectivity."

Objectives

To share three primary elements of the Operation Connectivity:

- The TEA will match the funds that LEAs put towards a bulk order of connectivity equipment and services to close its gap;
- Additional match funding is available from the TEA if LEAs can procure local CRF funding from the city or county; and,
- Funding may be subject to availability, demand, or a cap (to be determined).

Operational Impact

Denton ISD will be requesting matching funds for approximately 12,000 Chromebooks and 3,000 connectivity services (e.g. Hotspot, Jetpack).

Results

The connectivity devices and services will allow Denton ISD to provide 1:1 technology for students. This purchase will close the digital gap as on-line instruction becomes necessary during the COVID-19 period of concern.
