HES FRONT OFFICE UNDERGOES IMPROVEMENTS: Over the summer, the front office at Homedale Elementary has undergone some significant improvements that will enhance the look and feel of the office as well as improve visibility and safety in and around the office. Both windows in the front office (the front window where parents check students in and out, as well as the window that looks down the hallway toward the gymnasium) have been enlarged (almost double their original size) and new countertops were installed. This project will help eliminate significant blind spots and will create a more welcoming window and counter space for parents and patrons.
