SUCCESSES

All Students:

- Level II Increases in 7th Grade Math and Writing and 8th Grade Math, Reading, and Science.
- Level III Increases: 7th Grade Math and Writing and 8th Grade Math, Science, and Social Studies.
 - Most increases were around 6%, with the largest increase being in 7th Grade Writing which increased from 17% to 31%.

Targeted Student Groups:

- Special Education
 - Level II gains in 7th Grade Math and Writing and 8th Grade Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies.
 - Note: 8^{th} Grade Reading (61% \rightarrow 89%) and 8^{th} Grade Science (47% \rightarrow 90%)
 - Level III gains in 7th Grade Reading and Math and 8th Grade Reading, Science, and Social Studies.
- Economically Disadvantaged
 - Level II gains in 7th Grade Reading, Math, and Writing and 8th Grade Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies.
 - Level III gains in 7th Grade Reading and Writing and 8th Grade Math and Social Studies.
 - Note: 7th Grade Writing (2% → 22%)
- ESL/Hispanic
 - o Level II gains in 7th Grade Math and Writing and 8th Grade Math, Science, and Social Studies.
 - o Level III gains in 7th Grade Math and Writing and 8th Grade Math, Science, and Social Studies
 - Note: 7^{th} Grade Writing (4% \rightarrow 32%), 8^{th} Grade Science (16% \rightarrow 29%) and 8^{th} Grade Social Studies (11% \rightarrow 24%)
 - EOC Algebra I
 - o Level II 100%
 - o Level III 95%
- Increase in all Performance Indices
- Attendance Rate
 - o 96.3% → 97.38%

CHALLENGES

- Targeted Student Groups continue to underperform in relation to all students.
 - SpEd, ESL, and Eco-D
- Level II Performance in 8th Grade Social Studies
- Level III Performance in 7th and 8th Grade Reading



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WHAT'S NEXT

- Change in Remediation Program
 - o 8th Grade Reading Lab
 - o Focus on Direct Instruction (as opposed to computer program driven classroom)
- Daily implementation of CAT Time
 - o Daily opportunity for tutoring and remediation
- Administrative Data Tracking
 - Students not meeting progress measure
- Common Planning Times
 - o By grade level/subject to allow for more in-depth planning (instruction and intervention).
