Buffalo High School – Four bids were received and opened on March 15th.

Ogden/Brings to award bid to Palmer West Construction for \$839,300 to complete the re-roofing and masonry restoration at BHS along with Add Alternate Door/Landing for \$6250 and Unit Prices 3-9 from the bid tabulation sheet and to reject Add Alternate 2.

Discussion - Why reject the ladder? Adequate access is on this site. Alternate bid was not acceptable. Will complete the ladder project at a later time.

2. BCMS Pool Area Improvements

Opened bids last Thursday, March 24. Three were submitted but only one was complete. Recommend award of bid to Breitbach Construction.

Vander Kooi/Lee to award bid to Breitbach Construction for \$2,346,000 to complete the addition and alterations project at Buffalo Community Middle School, including Alternate 1 for liquidated damages and all unit prices 1-3 from the bid tabulation sheet and to reject Alternates 2-6.

Discussion - Time frame is for a start date of April 1st which is very optimistic. Completion dates are August 15 for swimmers to be in the pool and October 1st for remaining project additions.
