Board Approved:

I. Objective: To monitor implementation of the new state assessments.

- Strategy:
 - Receive a summary report on the administration of PARCC Assessments including technology readiness, standards implementation, student preparation, and professional development.

II. Objective: To support and monitor the development of the district's teacher performance evaluation plan (PERA).

- Strategies:
 - Receive periodic status reports on plan development
 - Allocate resources for professional development and plan development

III. Objective: To maintain fiduciary responsibility to the community through monthly financial reporting and an annual independent audit of school district finances, all with a commitment to ongoing compliance with all federal and state regulations, as well as applicable district policies and procedures.

- Strategies:
 - Evaluate a 5 year financial projection with consideration to anticipated major initiatives, pending legislation, economic conditions, and estimated fund balances.

VI. Objective: To identify and prioritize long-term and short-term maintenance and repair items in the school buildings.

 - Receive reports on the progress of facility assessment action items
