ELL Improvement Plan Actions:

1. Maximize ELD instruction time at the elementary schools, by using Wednesday mornings for additional ELD instruction groups or for assessment, which then keeps instruction time focused on instruction.
2. Provide continued professional development and coaching in effective ELS instructional strategies, collect data on these practices with the ELD Observation tool, provide feedback and focus support where needed.
3. Provide ongoing professional development and coaching at each school on effective sheltered instruction strategies, to support EL students in content classes. Collect data on these practices through the mini-observations, provide feedback and focus support where needed.
