#### What is **Flexible School Day**?

**TEC §29.0822** allows districts to offer alternative attendance schedules that count instructional hours rather than days of attendance. This serves students at risk of dropping out or with extenuating circumstances.

Districts receive full ADA funding based on completed instructional hours.



#### Application and Placement Process

#### 1. Initial Identification

At-risk student identification through Counselors/Principal/SPED/MTSS

Self-referral or Parent Request

#### 2. Recommendations

Principal/Counselor recommendation

MTSS or SPED recommendation

#### 3. Placement Meeting

Principal over FSD, Student's Courselor, Student and Parent(s) meet to determine if FSD is an appropriate placement

#### 4. Enrollment

Individualized Learning Plans for each student

Assign 4-hour Schedule

Enroll on FSD Calendar



#### Program **Pathways**

#### Short Term

Goal: Transition back to Mainstream learning



- IEP Created
- Student completes necessary credits to "catch up" with cohort peers

#### Student Identified as "At Risk"



#### **Examples:**

- Transition from inpatient physical/mental health facility
- Credit Recovery needed because of a move or temporary life event



#### **Examples:**

- · Major life event
- Difficulty reaching graduation requirements
- Older Students (11/12 Grade)
