Trustee Erekson calls the regular board meeting to order at 6:02PM.

- 4. **Announcement of Changes/Additions to the Agenda** Laurie Erekson stated Jeremy Griffin would be late because of traffic.
- **5.** Awards and Recognition-Spring Sports Banquet/ Athletic Director Kennedy spoke about the spring sports banquet being a success. Mr. Kennedy also mentioned the extreme shortage of buses available to shuttle students to sports events, band competition, and other student activities. Mr. Kennedy noted that it was questionable if they would be able to shuttle students to their activities, every time an activity arose. Additionally, he noted 42 athletes maintained 4.75 GPA's and 89% of the student population was involved in extracurricular activities, excluding clubs.

- 8.a. <u>MDSD 4 Day School Week Presentation/</u> High School Principal Sorensen shared findings about the 4-day school week in presentations that were posted on the MDSD website for the community to peruse. The board thanked the 4-day school week committee for their excellent work.
- 8.b. <u>HRS Principal Data Sheet/</u> Superintendent Thomas will present data to the board members at the board retreat.
- 8.c. <u>MDHS Art Grant/</u>Superintendent Thomas informed the board that Jared Hopkins the MDHS Art Teacher, was approved for the MDEF Art Grant for installing a pugmill at MDHS.
- 8.d. <u>Housing/</u>Superintendent Thomas indicated to the board that we currently have staff residing in the districts housing units. Additionally, Thomas indicated that the housing units being used for new recruits is yet to be seen, the district is unsure of their housing needs at this time.
